4) Experiential learning hours and internship experiences begin accruing <u>after</u> you are admitted to the program, and you should begin tracking them in a spreadsheet once admitted;

5) During your interview you will be asked to do a 5-7 minute <u>sales role play</u> on your choice of product or service. There are no set parameters other than you use the skills taught in MKT 313.

6) The Sales Leadership Minor has <u>a strict code of ethics</u>, and <u>ANY</u> forms of academic dishonesty will not be tolerated and could result in expulsion from the program and/or the university.
